

CY WILLIAMS



Cy Williams is in his 13th season as head coach of the UC Davis golf team, having completed an outstanding run in which the Aggies reached the NCAA D-II Championships for four consecutive seasons and won three West Region titles in four years.

Then in 2004, UC Davis entered its first season of a four-year transition to NCAA Division I membership. Williams' golf program

announced its presence into the new level with authority, beating out four future Big West Conference opponents en route to capturing the team title at UC Santa Barbara's Bite Pacific Coast Intercollegiate tourney.



In 2005, UC Davis struck again, repeating its team title at the Bite Pacific Coast Intercollegiate, but not before placing fi rst in the 13-team at the Diablo Grande Intercollegiate in Patterson, Calif. Furthermore, the Aggies enjoyed a second-place finish at the Prestige at PGA West in the fall.

The Aggies will become a full-fledged member of the Big West in 2007-08. In 2002, his team enjoyed a record-setting year that culminated with the team's third straight eighth-place fi nish at the national tournament. The Aggies won two tournament titles: the NCAA West Regional and the Aggie Invitational, the latter which featured the team scoring a school record of 30-underpar. For his efforts, Williams was named the NCAA West Region Coach of the Year.

Williams has been a member of the UC Davis golf staff since 1990. In 1996 and 1997 he was the acting head coach while coach Jim Sochor was coaching with the Scottish Claymores of the NFL Europe football league. When Sochor ended his coaching duties with the Aggies in 1997, Williams was named head coach on a permanent basis.

Williams played for the Aggies from 1984-87, participating at the NCAA Championships as a senior. He graduated from UC Davis in 1987 with a bachelor's degree in math and economics. Williams subsequently went to graduate school at UC Davis where he earned his master's degree (MAT) in math and his teaching credential. He became an assistant coach with the Aggies in 1990, also serving as acting head coach in 1991. He played some mini-tour events in California from 1990-93.

The Aggies were represented at the NCAA Championships each year from 1996 to 2003, fi nishing 15th in 1996, 13th in 1997, seventh in 1998 and tying for eighth every year from 2000 to 2002. Jeremy Price represented UC Davis as an individual selection in 1999. The fi ve top-10 fi nishes since 1998 are the highest since the program captured the national title in 1979. Williams has also mentored seven All-Americans during the past four seasons.

TODD HAMMOND



Todd Hammond is in his fifth season as an assistant coach at his alma mater with his primary function on player development. He will organize and run practices, with an emphasis on designing individual practice schedules for each player. Hammond focuses on short game routines, having attended the three-day Dave Pelz Short Game Clinic in Palm Springs. He learned Pelz' methods well and has enjoyed helping others with

that aspect of the sport. Hammond will also help with recruiting.

A 1986 graduate of UC Davis, he was a four-year starter on the Aggie golf team under Joe Carlson. Hammond competed at the NCAA Championships in 1983 and 1985, winning the NCAA Long Drive Competition in Houston in 1985 with a 285-yard average. He graduated with a degree in economics and promptly went to work as a photojournalist at the Davis Enterprise for the next 14 years. During that time, he competed in various amateur tournaments.

Hammond also has a photography business that he owns and operates with his wife, Barbara. His website, toddanbarbara.com, includes numerous photos of UC Davis' golfers and its home courses, including shots included in this media guide.

Todd "grew up" on the Davis Golf Course, working all facets of the golf business with his father, golf pro Curt Hammond.





2008-09 Recruits

Tyler Raber, a standout golfer from Davis High School who was the 2007 Delta Valley Conference most valuable player as well as his team's MVP, has signed a National Letter of Intent with UC Davis and will join the Aggies next fall, it was announced on Monday by head coach Cy Williams.

Raber joins the UC Davis program after posting an impressive 71.8 stroke average last season for Davis High School, claiming medalist honors with a 66 at the CIF-Sac-Joaquin Section Division I North Championships and sharing medalist honors at the Masters' Championships. He helped lead Davis High School to a runner-up finish at the section tournament

Raber went on to tie for fourth at the CIF-Northern California Boys Golf Championships, qualifying for the state championships. Besides being named his league's MVP last season, Raber was an All-Monticello Empire League first-team selection in 2005 and 2006 and has been named his team's MVP each of the past three seasons.

Raber, also the 2007 Sacramento Bee All-Metro Player of the Year and a first-team selection last season, has also highlighted 2007 by winning the California State Fair Boys Championship after a three-hole playoff. He is currently 46th nationally among 2008 graduates in the Polo Golf Rankings and posted a pair of top-six finishes this past summer in American Junior Golf Association events.

"We're very happy that Tyler has chosen UC Davis," said UC Davis coach Cy Williams. "He's had a lot of success in junior golf and has done well in the classroom. A big part of his success is that he is a very competitive person, and I think that attribute will help him succeed at the collegiate level and will help make our team better. He's from Davis, and it's been fun to watch him grow and mature into a very talented athlete. We can't wait to get started working with him."

Dennis Carson, a standout golfer from Junipero Serra High School in San Mateo, has signed a National Letter of Intent with UC Davis and will join the Aggie men's golf team this fall, head coach Cy Williams has announced.

In addition to prepping at Junipero Serra, Carson spent the 2006-07 academic year at The Pendleton School and the highly acclaimed David Leadbetter Golf Academy in Florida.

At Serra, Carson helped lead his prep team to Central Coast Section championships in 2005 and 2006 as well as a West Catholic Athletic title in 2005. The Padres entered this month with a 10-1 record and a first-place standing in their league with Carson carrying a 34.5 stroke average for nine holes.

He has several notable wins including victories on the California Junior Tour this year at the Metropolitan Open and in 2007 at Rancho Canada. Carson also posted an individual title in 2007 on the Future Collegiate World Tour and in 2005 was the Northern California Junior State Champion.

Additionally, Carson finished third at the 2006 California State Junior Amateur, has represented the Junior Golf Association of Northern California in selected North-South matches in 2006, and in 2004 was a member of a USA team that competed in Scotland in World Cup matches.

"We're very happy to have Dennis join our program," said Aggie coach Cy Williams. "Not only is he an outstanding athlete but he really wanted to come here, and that means a lot to us. With his talent, competitive nature and willingness to work hard he'll help the depth of our team. He has the skills to compete for a starting position right away and we look for him to come in and do just that."
